Andrea D. Willis, MD, MPH, FAAP



Dr. Andrea D. Willis is senior vice president and chief medical officer for BlueCross BlueShield of Tennessee, which has more than 6,000 employees and serves more than 3.4 million members in the state and across the country. In this role, Willis guides BlueCross' clinical processes that are central to improving the health and well-being of all members.

She oversees Total Health Management and pharmacy management and is responsible for achieving and maintaining clinical quality excellence, optimizing member care and medical management functions, oversight of clinical risk management and collaborating with the provider community. Willis serves as the clinical face of the organization with customers, providers, regulators and other stakeholders, as well as employees and board of directors.

Prior to joining BlueCross, Willis was director of CoverKids and was responsible for developing Tennessee's federally approved State Children's Health Insurance Program (SCHIP). She also previously served as deputy commissioner for the Tennessee Department of Health. She had a key role creating and implementing the statewide initiatives Better Health: It's About Time and Respect Your Health.

Willis is a fellow with the American Academy of Pediatrics and a member of the Tennessee Medical Association. She serves on the Nashville Health Governing Board and Governor's Foundation for Health and Wellness. She's served on the board of directors for the Tennessee Institute of Public Health and the Institutional Review Board for Tennessee Department of Health.

Willis earned a Master of Public Health from Johns Hopkins School of Hygiene and Public Health and a Doctor of Medicine from Georgetown University School of Medicine. She received her Bachelor of Science from the University of Alabama at Birmingham, earning the Alpha Kappa Alpha Award for Academic Achievement.
