Herbert Ann "Herbie" Krisle (pronounced CRY suhl) is the executive director of Page Robbins Adult Day Center in Collierville. Having been a caregiver for her mother who suffered from vascular dementia and Alzheimer's disease for 10 years, she is keenly aware of the stresses caregivers feel. Page Robbins is an independent non-profit organization that provides unique and uplifting care for adults with memory loss, in a safe environment while empowering and educating their caregivers and the community.

Herbie's work at Page Robbins brings her great joy; she serves an incredible board of directors and leads a staff with minimal employee turnover allowing each staff member to know their role and do it well, providing exceptional care.

Prior to her work with Page Robbins, Herbie spent 11 years at the MidSouth Food Bank, 11 years with Malone and Hyde/Fleming Wholesale Grocers and 5 years with the University of Tennessee Agricultural Extension Service as a 4-H Club Agent.

Herbie is extremely engaged in the Collierville community. She is an active member of the Collierville Rotary Club, Collierville Chamber of Commerce and the Collierville United Methodist Church where she is a Stephen Minister and sings in the Chancel Choir and an occasional soloist. She has one daughter, Meg who is a Deputy with the Putnam County (TN) Sheriff's Department and a Captain in the Mississippi Army National Guard and Commander of the 114th MP Company.
