She specializes in custom designed furniture, space planning furnishings and finishes specifications and sustainable design issues. Leslie is also a Certified Aging in Place Specialist and a Certified Green Professional. She is on the boards of two local non-profit environmental groups and has served on the ASID's national committee on "Aging in Place." She recently served in an advisory capacity to the Plough Foundation, helping to implement a pilot program focused on Aging in Place for the City of Memphis. Additionally as a member of the International Codes Council, she is involved in all manner of accessibility issues and the codes that affect them.

Leslie has received numerous awards and honors. Among her many awards, she is most proud of The National Homebuilder's Association 2008 National "Homes for Life" design award for a kitchen she designed utilizing Universal Design and Sustainable Design components.
