Matt Thompson is President and CEO of the Memphis Zoo. With more than 25 years of experience serving the Memphis Zoo. Matt has served in many roles, first as a Zookeeper, then working his way up to Executive Vice President and now CEO. Matt's educational back-

ground and his passion for animals has been apparent in the successful development and implementation of the Zoo's long-term goals and growth. His love for Memphis and the Zoo is evident in his everyday interactions with staff and animals. At the same time, his dedication to staff development has brought a level of engagement and dedication to the employees and peers.

Matt has both a passion for and extensive knowledge of animal programs. At the Zoo, he leads more than 350 employees and 150 volunteers and oversees the care and management of more than 3,500 animals representing more than 500 species. The Zoo's animal inhabitants reside in one-of-a-kind exhibits, such as Once Upon A Farm, The Commercial Appeal Cat Country, Primate Canyon, Animals of the Night, Northwest Passage, Teton Trek, CHINA - home to giant pandas YaYa and LeLe. A highlight of Matt's career was going to China in 2003 to escort the pandas to Memphis. In addition, he is interested in animal behavior, husbandry, and the business and operational side of zoos and aquariums. Consistently ranked as one of the nation's top zoos, the Memphis Zoo proudly showcases a diverse animal collection and a talented team of professionals dedicated to the Zoo's mission of "Creating Adventure and Saving Wildlife."

When not working at the Zoo, Matt enjoys spending time with his family, DIY projects, and working outdoors.
