After school, Alex landed at the renowned Wild Turkey Distillery in the heart of Kentucky's bour-

bon belt as a production supervisor. Her education and experience in the spirits industry made her a natural fit when cousins Alex and Chris Canale sought to revive their great, great grandfather's long-dominant spirits brand in 2015. As Old Dominick's head distiller, Alex was instrumental in the development of the distillery facilities and the production of the first spirits to roll off the line. In January 2 019, Alex was promoted to Master Distiller, a testament to her passion and dedication to craft. In December 2019, she was promoted again to Master Distiller and Senior Vice President.
